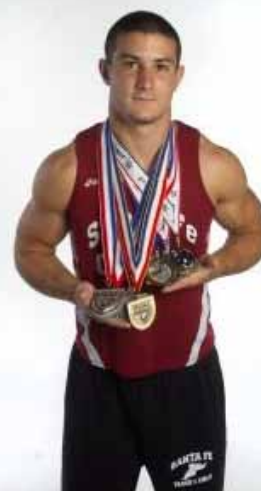

Dear Friends,



## Leadership Team Restructured



Gwen Coté, Glenda Pierce and Matt Franzino have led the Santa Fe Catholic Community for the last five years. Combined they have 33 years of leadership at Santa Fe Catholic and 58 years total of high school leadership experience.

Ms. Coté was hired as principal six years ago and with the transition to a president/principal governance structure, she has served as president for the past three years. Mrs. Pierce has served as

a teacher, dean of students Gwen Coté, Glenda Pierce and Matt Franzino have led the Santa Fe Catholic Community for the last five years. Combined they have 33 years of leadership at Santa Fe Catholic and 58 years total of high school leadership experience.

Ms. Coté was hired as principal six years ago and with the transition to a president/principal governance structure, she has served as president for the past three years. Mrs. Pierce has served as a teacher, dean of students and assistant principal of curriculum for 17 years.

The newest dimension to the SFC leadership team is Mr. Franzino, assuming the role of principal. Matt distinguished himself in that program and was chosen to receive a grant that would pay for his Master's in Educational Leadership from Barry University. Mr. Franzino currently lives in Lakeland with his wife and three sons. They are members of the Church of the Resurrection and Mr. Franzino's wife, Courtney, is a school guidance counselor at Resurrection Catholic School, where their children now attend. The Franzinos are devoted to Catholic education and lead by example. Mr. Franzino looks forward to working closer with the families and students of Santa Fe Catholic High School, and knows that God has continued his career with Santa Fe Catholic where he can share his strengths and leadership abilities for many years to come.

School President Gwen Coté commented, "Having worked with Matt for the last five years, I trust his judgment and his willingness to work hard for the good of the Santa Fe Community. I look forward with great hope and promise to the coming year working with Matt in his new responsibilities as principal."

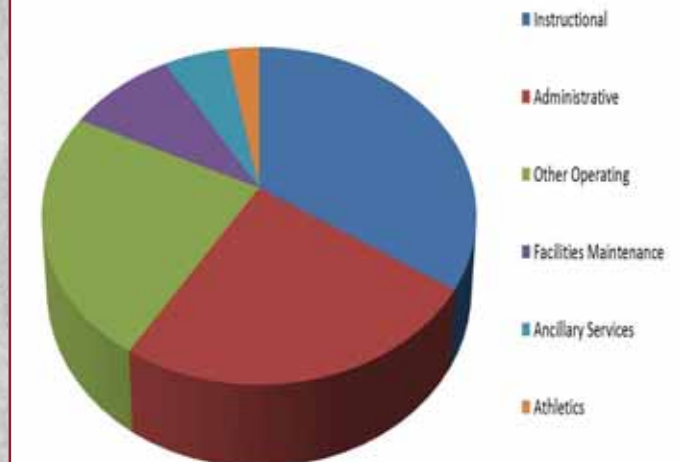
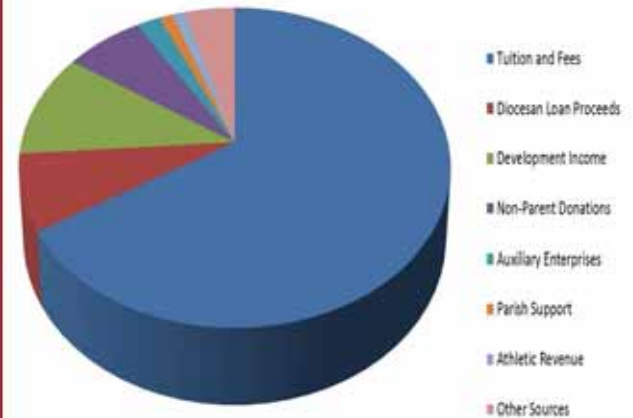

## John A. R. Martocci, Generous Benefactor

**Santa Fe Catholic High School was the recipient of a \$221,000 bequest from the estate of the late John A.R. Martocci.** According to Mr. James Weaver, Co-Trustee of the John A.R. Martocci Revocable Trust, "Uncle Johnny's heart was huge, and anyone who knew him, could see this right away. Children, especially underprivileged children, were the ones who touched his heart the most. Uncle Johnny was a friend of the Santa Fe Catholic High School community in Lakeland, Florida, and an advocate and supporter of secondary Catholic education in Polk County for many years. Uncle Johnny's wishes were to provide a 'special gift' to Santa Fe Catholic so as to ensure the immediate continuation of their ministry and their tradition of educating young men and women, by preparing them with a solid academic and spiritual foundation for college and so that, God willing, these young men and women may become the leaders that our world needs these present times."

Mr. Martocci's blessings and shared gifts have made it possible for us to remodel and upgrade classroom technology this past summer, as well as to purchase new air-conditioning units for the media center and Martin Power Center. Following John Martocci's wishes, Ms. Gwen Coté and our Board of Advisors have made provisions to transfer \$100,000.00 from the bequest to the Santa Fe Catholic Endowment and Charitable Trust to increase the corpus of the Martocci Endowment within the SFC Trust to continue to provide financial aid to our deserving students. A close friend of Uncle Johnny, Mr. Jason A. Penrod, Esq., stated, "Mr. Martocci wished to encourage others in our community to support Catholic education by way of making arrangements through planned giving, especially by proving scholarships to support families most in need of assistance to afford their children a Catholic education."

Rigorous landscaping with new mulch and rock, tree trimming and clearing of debris, has resulted in a very attractive campus. The gymnasium court has been refinished with our new athletic Hawk logo - and it looks fabulous! Mrs. Pfund and her loyal companions, Mrs. Redman and art students, painted a mural behind the statue of St. Francis. We are also in the process of clearing land for future growth. Last but not least, the Santa Fe Community is blessed to be working with a group of dedicated alumni to enhance the frontage of the property. All of these gifts have been in-kind contributions and bear no cost to Santa Fe Catholic. 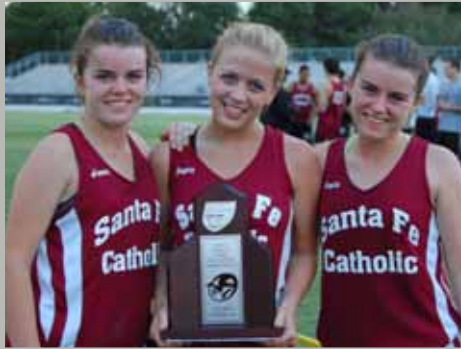

**Boys Basketball** - Eliminated Lakeland Christian in the Districts to advance to Regionals.

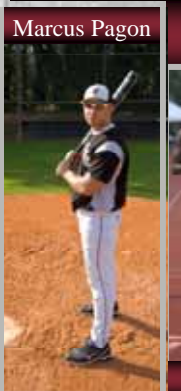

## A Message from Our Board of Trustees President

2011 has been another exciting year at SFC. The school board and the executive committee have been very active driving Institutional Advancement through focused efforts centered on our Strategy Mapping process. In April, your board representatives attended the 2011 National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) Conference in New Orleans, LA. At the conference, we were presented with the National Board of the Year Award recognizing our many outstanding achievements. The purpose of this award is to acknowledge outstanding work, share ideas and best practices, and encourage excellence. Academically, our administration and faculty continue to set the bar high with an aggressive curriculum that clearly prepares our students for college and the world. This year, over \$2.4 million in scholarship funds were received by our 70 graduating seniors.

SFC completed another outstanding year athletically. We achieved District titles in track and field, soccer and basketball. Our baseball, cross country, softball, swimming, volleyball, boys and girls soccer and basketball all advanced to Regionals. This year we had 37 students attend Catholic Heart Work Camp in Mississippi. Additionally, 14 students were trained and commissioned as Holy Communion Ministers this year. We are blessed to have such a strong commitment to faith in our community.
