Frequently Asked Questions

We are glad you are interested in becoming a Crimsonette! Here are some things that you should consider when making a commitment to the dance team.

How much time is involved?

Dance team is a year-round sport, beginning with Summer dance camp. In the fall we practice Mondays-Thursdays from 3:15-5:00, every week to prepare for home football half-time performances on Friday.

We perform at two basketball halftimes, march in the Lakeland Christmas parade in December and host Jr. Crimsonette dance camp in January. February is dance competition, and during March we perform at the LHS Showcase with other area dance teams, and Resurrection's Mardi Gras. During April we prepare for spring Tryouts.

Is participation required?

Yes, participation is required for all events and fundraisers. We strive to create a "team" environment and these are essential elements.

When is Summer Camp?

Dancers attend summer dance camp each year at various universities in central Florida. The typical cost for camp and dance wear is approximately \$500.

Are there other costs involved? Actual costs depend upon how much we raise each year doing fundraising. While



the official SFC uniform is paid for by the school, with help from the Booster Club, parents hold the primary responsibility for funding the cost of dance camp, costumes, competitions, etc.

What about Fundraising?

Parents are encouraged (and sometimes required) to help with fundraising. We work at the concession stand in the fall, host Middle School Boot Camp and Jr. Crimsonette Dance camp and other things to raise money.

Is there a Code of Conduct?

Crimsonettes are held to the highest standards with respect to maintaining integrity, politeness, courtesy, good sportsmanship, enthusiasm in performances, positive attitude at all times, and academic excellence and community service. Dancers are proud to hold the **Academic/Athletic Team Highest GPA** award for four years. Each girl must maintain a minimum GPA in order to perform.
