

Dear Parents:

I am pleased to announce that Santa Fe Catholic HS will be offering a trip to Italy and Greece in 2015. This is a 13 day trip from June 24th to July 6th.

The highlights of the itinerary are;

3 nights in Rome, including visits to Vatican City, the Roman catacombs, the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, the Pantheon, the Trevi Fountain, Spanish steps, Piazza Navona

1 night in the Sorrento region, including visits to Capri and Pompeii

1 night on the ferry to Greece

1 night in Delphi, with visits to ancient Delphi and its museum

2 nights in Athens, with visits to the Acropolis, its museum, the Plaka district

3 nights on a Greek island cruise with visits to 5 ports: Mykonos, Kusadasi, Patmos, Crete, and Santorini. Three shore excursions are included: ancient Ephesus at Kusadasi, the Minoan palace at Knossos on Crete, and Oia Village on Santorini. (Additional shore excursions can be purchased on the ship.)

The price is \$4725 for students and \$5340 for adults 20 and over. This is an almost all-inclusive price. It includes:

Round trip airfare

Hotels

Breakfast and dinner daily and all three meals on the Greek island cruise

Sightseeing tours

Trip insurance

Full time tour director

A Greek evening excursion

A \$100 discount is included in the above price if booking is made by October 31. Various payment plans are available.

This will be my 4th Santa Fe trip. They have all been wonderful!! Speaking of which, anyone who traveled with us on any of the three previous trips will receive an additional discount.
